**TRACK RULES**

1. The BHS Racing track will be open for training and conditioning April 1, 2008 weather permitting.
2. Stalls must be applied for and approved before any horse may be stalled on the grounds. **STALLS MUST BE APPLIED FOR BY APRIL 1, 2008.**
3. Stakes Horses will be given preference in stalls. Any horse stalled on the grounds that does not start, will be charged a \$150.00 stall rent fee. A \$10.00 cleaning deposit for each stall will be charged to the Trainers. Trainers in good standing who have previously raced in Miles City will be given first choice of stalls. Horses trained on the grounds after April 1<sup>st</sup> and before May 4<sup>th</sup> will be charged \$2 per day per horse.
4. Phone entries will be accepted; papers and all payments must be in the race office prior to post time.
5. All rules and/or new rules adopted by the Montana Board of Horse Racing will supersede any condition of the track.
6. All Paint horse races must have a minimum of 6 paid up entries to constitute a race.

**RULES FOR PAINT HORSE RACES**

There will be two paint horse stakes races. Each race will not consist of more than eight (8) horses. Paint Horse Futurity will run Sunday May 18th. The Paint Horse Derby will run Saturday May 17th. All eligible horses for both races must be a registered Paint horse. In the running of the Paint horse race, if a starting gate fails to open and the money wagered on the horse is refunded to the public, such a horse will be declared and nonstarter and classified as a scratched horse. Twelve or more horses are nominated and paid up by May 8th there will be trials run on May 11th. If less than twelve and more than eight are paid up horses will draw for postposition and unsuccessful horses' money refunded. The decisions of the stewards shall be final.

**ALL FEES MUST BE PAID 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME. NO EXECEPTIONS!**

**PURSE**

All nomination fees and entry fees, less ten percent (10%) handling and advertising costs, plus added money will be divided as stated in the program schedule. In case of inclement weather the management may change the distance if moving the starting gate would be a hazard to the horses or personnel with the approval of the Montana Board of Horse Racing.

**TRAINERS WILL BE RESPONSIBLE TO KNOW THE CONDITIONS OF THE HORSE THEY ENTER. IF THE HORSE IS ENTERED THAT DOES NOT FIT THE CONDITIONS, YOUR NOMINATION AND ENTERY FEE WILL NOT BE REFUNDED, AND THE HORSE WILL BE SCRATCHED.**

 Distance 300 yards  
 Futurity Eligibility: Open to paint horse foals of 2006  
 Purse Split: 1-60%, 2-20%, 3-11%, 4-6%, 5-3%  
 No sex Allowance. Wt. 124lbs

**PAINT HORSE DERBY**

**(\$2500 added)**

Trials May 11<sup>th</sup>, if necessary. Finals: May 17th  
 Distance 350 yards  
 Derby Eligibility: Open to paint horse foals of 2005  
 Purse Split 1-60%, 2-20%, 3-11%, 4-6%, 5-3%  
 No Sex Allowance Wt 124lbs

**Entry into the trials will be by 10 a.m. Thursday May 8<sup>th</sup>, 2008 for both the Futurity and Derby.**
